The expression "Bible canon" came to denote the collection, or list, of books accepted as genuine inspired Scripture. The term "canon" is derived from the Hebrew word qa·neh' (reed). Reeds were used as a rule or measuring device. Fittingly, the Bible canon, or catalog of inspired books, enables the reader to "measure" faith, doctrine, and conduct. The canon of the Hebrew Scriptures was established by the end of the fifth century B.C.E.

The word canon, in classical Greek, is properly a straight rod, "a rule" in the widest sense, and especially in the phrases "the rule of the Church," "the rule of faith," "the rule of truth," The first direct application of the term canon to the Scriptures seems to be in the verses of Amphilochius (cir. 380 A.D.), where the word indicates the rule by which the contents of the Bible must be determined, and thus secondarily an index of the constituent books.

### Canon of Scripture, The Definition and Meaning - Bible ...

The "canon" of Scripture is defined as the books of the Bible officially accepted as Holy Scripture. Written by about forty authors over the course of 1500 years, it was essential that a list be drawn up of the books which reflected the truth of God's message and were inspired by the Holy Spirit.

When biblical scholars use the word "canon," they refer to the collection of Scriptures that Jews or Christians consider have binding authority. But, of course, today there is not just one canon, but multiple; different Christian groups sometimes have different biblical canons.

Thus they endorse as genuine and authentic the canon of the Jewish Scriptures. The Septuagint Version (q.v.) also contained every book we now have in the Old Testament Scriptures. As to the time at which the Old Testament canon was closed, there are many considerations which point to that of Ezra and Nehemiah, immediately after the return from Babylonian exile.
