Create a risk assessment matrix. Another approach is to use a risk assessment matrix, which helps you determine how likely or unlikely a risk may occur in your workplace. The matrix will have a column for "Consequence and Likelihood", which is divided into: Rare: May occur only in exceptional circumstances. Unlikely: Could occur at some time.
